Which exam should I take? IELTS Regular, IELTS for UKVI or Life Skills?

The exam you take depends on the use you want to give your result. We suggest you contact the organisation that is requesting your IELTS result so you can be clear about the following specific questions:

- Should you register for the regular version of IELTS, or the UKVI IELTS or Life Skills?
- If you need the regular IELTS test version, should you opt for the General Training or the Academic test?
- If you need to take IELTS for UKVI or Life Skills, the test will depend on the type of visa you are applying for (Tier 1,2,3 or 4). It is highly important that you are clear on what visa or TIER you need before registering for the IELTS test. Here are some useful contacts:

Which is easier, IELTS or Life Skills?

IELTS and Life Skills are two different types of tests. Some obvious differences are:

- IELTS tests the four skills (speaking, listening, reading, writing)
- Life Skills tests only speaking and listening, which means Life Skills is a shorter test than IELTS.

What is the difference between the paper-based IELTS exam and the computer-delivered IELTS exam?

The content and cost of both versions of the exam are the same. If you choose to take the computer-delivered IELTS, you will submit your responses through a computer for the reading, writing and listening sections. The speaking section continues to be face to face with a qualified IELTS examiner.

The computer-delivered IELTS test offers more flexibility with regards to available dates, your speaking test may be taken on the same day as the other sections or during one week before or after the date you have selected to take your written IELTS exam. Your results will be issued within seven days.

Please note that as of April 2020, IELTS for UKVI (Academic and General Training) is only computer-delivered.

Please note also that we are currently only offering the computer-delivered IELTS test.

- IELTS Academic or General Training: 810 soles (British Council)
- IELTS for UKVI Academic or General Training: 863 soles
- IELTS Life Skills A1 or B1: 654 soles

When is my speaking test? Is it on the same date as the other parts of the test?

For the regular version of IELTS (non-UKVI), during the registration process you will have the option to choose your speaking test date from a list of available dates.

For UKVI IELTS and Life Skills, candidates will be informed by the test centre (by e-mail) when, where and at what time the speaking test will take place.

Speaking tests for computer-delivered IELTS may be scheduled on the same day as the rest of the exam or during one week before or after the date you have selected to take your written IELTS exam.

Why is the "Country or Region of Origin" field blank on my test result form (TRF)?

This is because both your citizenship and country of origin are the same. When these are different, then both fields are filled in.

Are IELTS results certified by Cambridge University?

IELTS is jointly owned by the British Council, IDP Australia and Cambridge English Language Assessment. Test Result Forms (TRFs) are issued with all three logos of these institutions.
